


"Remote Control - Digital Youth Work" was a project that consisted of two mobilities, 2 Training Courses that took place in the region of Trikala, Greece in November 2021 and February 2022, under Erasmus+ Programme (KA1 – Mobility of Youth Yorkers). The second mobility, the Training Course "Virtual Facilitators" took place in the city of Trikala, Greece, between 25 February - 7 March 2022

The project reunited 22 young people from 8 different countries: Portugal, Greece, Poland, North Macedonia, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus and Romania and provided them with digital tools and knowledge to give them tools for effective remote Youth Work.





Through the implementation of non-formal education methods, the participants were able to acquire new skills while engaging with other young people in a thriving multicultural environment.




More about Erasmus+ Programmes

YOUTH EXCHANGES

- 5 to 21 days
- For young people who are unexperienced on the topic
- 13 to 30 years old
- Minimum group size is 5 (4+1 youth leader)




TRAINING COURSES

- 5 to 21 days
- For young workers who are experienced on the topic
- Minimum 18 years old
- Maximum 3 people (no team leader)



EUROPEAN SOLIDARITY CORPS (ESC)

- 17 to 30 years old
- Unpaid and full-time voluntary service
- Short time 2 weeks to 2 months
- Long time 2 months to 12 months



YOUTHPASS

- Learning to learn
- Mathematical competence and basic competences in science and technology
- Communication in foreign languages
- Communication in the mother tongue
- Digital competence
- Interpersonal, intercultural and social competences and civic competence
- Cultural expression
- Entrepeurnership
